Throwers have no finish line...

President Droupadi Murmu on Monday congratulated Neeraj Chopra and said his performance will inspire millions of the country's youth. "India is proud of Neeraj Chopra. I convey my heartiest congratulations to him. I wish his legend grows with more such feats," she said.

Prime Minister Modi on Monday hailed Neeraj Chopra, saying his dedication, precision and passion make him not just a champion in athletics but a symbol of unparalleled excellence in the entire sports world.

Neeraj Chopra has arguably become India's greatest sportsperson of all time but the slightest reference makes the newly-crowned World Champion uncomfortable.

Chopra, who is known for his humility besides his world conquering skills with javelin, won the coveted world title with a solid throw of 88.17m in Budapest on Sunday night.

He is also the first track and field athlete from India to win an Olympic gold.

There is no doubt over who is the all-time greatest Indian track and field athlete but the ever modest Chopra doesn't want to get involved in that debate.

"I will never say this, the greatest of all time. People say that just the world Championships gold is missing. I won it now but I have many things left to do and I will focus on that. I would not like to say this (greatest of all time).

"If you want to say greatest of all time, it would have to be like Jan Zelezny," he said in the context of world record holder in javelin.

Zelezny is the legendary Czech Republic javelin thrower, who holds the world record of 98.48m and won three Olympic and three World Championships gold. He is also Chopra's idol.

Besides the Tokyo Olympics gold, Chopra has won the yellow metal in the Asian Games (2018) and Commonwealth Games (2018). He has also won four individual Diamond League Meeting titles (two each in 2022 and 2023) apart from Diamond League champion's trophy last year.

He also became junior world champion in 2016 and won the Asian Championships title in 2017.

So, what remains to achieve now?

"There is a saying that throwers have no finish line. The best thing is that we have our javelin. We can always push ourselves. I may have won a lot of medals but the motivation is to throw farther and farther," Chopra said during a virtual interaction.

"By winning these medals, I should not think that I have achieved everything. I will work harder, push myself harder to win more medals and bring more laurels for my country. If other Indians join me on the podium next time, that will be great," he said. The talk of throwing 90m has been going on for the last three-four years but Chopra insisted that it's not a mental hurdle for him.

"I was feeling very good this year and thought I would throw 90m. But in between groin injury has come and created problem. I had throws very close to 90m last year. It will come some day but don't know when. I won't take pressure thinking for that.

"What is more important is the medal. I give more importance to consistency, that gives confidence in big events.

"When I reach 90m, I will also try to keep it consistent. I have been working hard and waiting when will it come," said the 25-year-old Chopra, in ominous signs for the rest of rivals in the world.

He said it was a dream come true to win the World Championships gold medal.

"This was great. After the Olympic gold, I really wanted to win the World Championships. I just wanted to throw farther. This is brilliant for the national team, but it was my dream to win

gold at the World Championships.

"This has been a great championships for India, and I am proud to bring another title to my country. I wanted to throw more than 90 metres tonight but it needs all parts of the puzzle to be there. I couldn't put it all together this evening. Maybe next time."

Not 100 per cent fit, recent groin injury in mind

Chopra had suffered a groin injury (adductor muscles) while training abroad in between his two Diamond League titles in Doha (May) and Lausanne (June 30).

That led to him missing three top competitions.

He rested and trained for nearly two months after June 30 without taking part in any competition after June 30 and went straight to World Championships.

"I thought I can produce very good throws till the last attempt. But I had to be cautious, thinking about the groin strain and at the same time had to push myself. I had to take care of my adductor (muscles) and focus on my throws also, that was the issue," he said.

"I will try to be healthy and remain injury-free, prepare and try the best way possible for Paris Olympics," said the Indian superstar.

Rivalry between him and Pakistan's Arshad Nadeem Chopra said he will not take the portrayal of his competition with Arshad Nadeem, who won a silver on Sunday with a throw of 87.82m, as Indo-Pak javelin rivalry too seriously.

"It is being made like that (Indo-Pak rivalry) there (at home). I don't use mobile much before competition but when I opened I saw India vs Pakistan everywhere. It's all right.

"There (back home) we always have this India-Pakistan thing, that is good for competition but in global events we have to focus on every competitor."

Chopra has now become only the second Indian -- after legendary shooter Abhinav Bindra -- to simultaneously hold the Olympics and World Championships titles. Bindra had won the World Championships title when he was 23, and the Olympics gold at 25.

The Prime Minister said India had emerged as the fastest growing economy and would soon be among the top three economies in the world during this decade and bring benefits to the common man.

"For any economy to grow, it is imperative that every sector develops. From the food sector to pharmaceuticals, from space to start-ups, when every sector grows the economy will move ahead," he said.

He said the tourism sector alone was expected to contribute Rs 20 lakh crore to the economy by 2030 and had the potential to create 13-14 crore new jobs.

Look into suspension of lecturer who argued against abrogation of Art 370 in J&K: SC to AG

NEW DELHI, Aug 28 (PTI)

THE Supreme Court on Monday asked Attorney General R Venkataramani and Solicitor General Tushar Mehta to look into the issue of the suspension of Jammu and Kashmir education department lecturer who had argued before the top court in a matter related to the abrogation of Article 370.

A five-judge bench headed by Chief Justice D Y Chandrachud took note of the suspension of Zahoor Ahmad Bhat, who had argued before the top court on August 24 as petitioner in-person in the case.

As soon as the court resumed its hearing, senior advocates Kapil Sibal and Rajeev Dhavan pointed out that Bhat was suspended from his job by the Jammu and Kashmir administration after having argued before

the top court. "He took leave for two days. Argued before this court and went back and was suspended," Sibal said.

The bench, also comprising Justices Sanjay Kishan Kaul, Sanjiv Khanna, BR Gavai and Surya Kant, asked Venkataramani to talk to the J-K Lieutenant Governor and look into the issue. "This should not happen. Someone arguing before this court gets suspended..." the bench said.

Venkataramani replied that he will look into the issue.

Mehta said after the news of Bhat's suspension was published in a newspaper, he checked with the administration and he was informed that there were various reasons behind the lecturer's suspension including that he has been regularly filing petitions before different courts.



Ten-time Nagaland MLA Noke Wangnao no more

DIMAPUR, Aug 28 (PTI)

TEN-time Nagaland MLA Noke Wangnao died at a hospital in Dimapur on Monday after a brief illness.

Wangnao, the oldest member of the current Assembly, was 87 and survived by his wife and six children.

A staunch regionalist, Wangnao joined politics in 1974 and got elected from the Tapi constituency in Mon district 10 times. He served the State in various

capacities, including as a Minister. Having been elected as a Nationalist Democratic

Progressive Party (NDPP) candidate in the Assembly elections in February, he served as an advisor for the Social Welfare Department till his death.

He died while undergoing treatment at the Christian Institute of Health Sciences and Research in Dimapur. State honors were given to him at his residence in Dimapur.



Go First flight cancellations extended until August 31 citing 'operational reasons'

NEW DELHI, Aug 28 (ANI)

GO FIRST airlines, which has been grounded since early May, has announced a further extension of flight cancellations till August 31, the airline announced on Monday.

Taking to social media platform X, the airlines said, "Due to operational reasons, Go First flights until 31st August 2023 are cancelled. We apologise for the inconvenience caused and request customers to visit http://shorturl.at/jlrEZ for more information. For any queries or concerns, please feel free to contact us."

Go First has also issued a statement, which it has posted along with the social media post, saying that the company has filed an application for immediate resolution and revival of operation. "As you are aware, the company

has filed an application for immediate resolution and revival of operations. We will be able to resume bookings shortly," the airline stated.

Earlier on May 2, Go First cancelled its flights and filed for voluntary bankruptcy before the NCLT, alleging delays on the part of a US-based engine maker, Pratt and Whitney, for its inability to promptly meet obligations -- leading to the grounding of a portion of its fleet.

"We regret to inform that due to operational reasons, Go First flights scheduled till August 31, 2023 have been cancelled. We apologise for the inconvenience caused by the flight cancellations. We acknowledge the flight cancellations might have disrupted your travel plans and we are committed to providing all the assistance we can," Go First said in the statement.

52 get jail terms, 35 acquitted in fodder scam case
