Raj CM Gehlot reads out excerpts of previous Budget, uproar in House

JAIPUR, Feb 10 (PTI)

RAJASTHAN Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot on Friday read excerpts of the previous Budget instead of Budget 2023-24, the major goof-up leading to an uproar in the House and an apology from the Chief Minister who said it was human error.

He said whatever happened was unfortunate. Human errors, he said, happen and are rectified. When the House reassembled after the second adjournment, the Chief Minister said, "I am feeling sorry. An extra page was added by mistake. It was human error."

There were two adjournments with the Opposition BJP alleging that the budget had been leaked and the presentation be postponed to another date.

Raje, who was present in the House, hit back, saying what Gehlot had done was sheer carelessness. "Koi bhi CM is tarah se kaagaz nahin laate. Aisa hoga toh Rajasthan kya hoga (No CM comes with papers like this. What will happen to the State if the Chief Minister does something like this)," she said.

Free power to farmers consuming less than 2,000 units per month

JAIPUR, Feb 10 (PTI)

GEHLOT on Friday announced free electricity to more than 11 lakh farmers who consume less than 2,000 units per month. Providing uninterrupted power supply for farming is a priority, the CM said in his Budget speech.

Farmers consuming up to 2,000 units per month will get free electricity from the 2023-24 financial year, Gehlot said. He also announced the enactment of the Rajasthan Farmers Debt Relief Act in order to protect the land of small and marginal farmers from being auctioned off.

SC says, Centre, probe agencies not going after big fish of international drug syndicates

NEW DELHI, Feb 10 (PTI)

THE Supreme Court on Friday said the Centre and investigating agencies are not arresting big fish who are members of international drug syndicates but catching small fish like agriculturists and someone standing at a bus stand in NDPS cases. The remarks of the top court came on a bail plea of an accused who was arrested after opium was found in his fields and has served more than five years in jail.
