Rupee soars 73 paise against US dollar

MUMBAI, Sept 1 (PTI)

THE rupee rallied 73 paise to breach the 73-mark against the US dollar on Tuesday, supported by liquidity-boosting measures announced by the RBI. A weak greenback overseas and a positive trend in the equity markets further supported the local currency, Forex traders said. At the interbank forex market, the domestic unit opened at 73.18 against the US dollar and shuttled between 72.75 and 73.19. It finally finished at 72.87, up 73 paise from its previous close of 73.60. The dollar index, which gauges the greenback's strength against a basket of six currencies, was trading 0.25 per cent lower at 91.91. The Reserve Bank on Monday announced a host of steps, including term repo operations totalling Rs 1 lakh crore in mid-September to ease pressure on liquidity and maintain congenial financial conditions with a view to ensuring sustainable recovery of economic growth.

CIL to invest over Rs 1.22 lakh crore by 2023-24, says Coal Minister

NEW DELHI, Sept 1 (PTI)

STATE-OWNED CIL will pump in over Rs 1.22 lakh crore on projects related to coal evacuation, exploration and clean coal technologies by 2023-24, to achieve 1 billion tonnes of fuel output target, Coal Minister Pralhad Joshi said on Tuesday.

Out of the proposed spend of over 1.22 lakh crore, Coal India Ltd (CIL) has planned to invest Rs 32,696 crore on coal evacuation, Rs 25,117 crore on mine infrastructure and Rs 29,461 crore on project development by 2023-24, the minister said while addressing a stakeholders' meet organised by the PSU through video conferencing. He added that the state-owned company will also invest Rs 32,199 on diversification and clean coal technologies, Rs 1,495 crore on social infrastructure and Rs 1,893 crore

Hero MotoCorp sales rise 7.55% in August month

NEW DELHI, Sept 1 (PTI)

THE country's largest two-wheeler maker Hero MotoCorp on Tuesday reported a 7.55 per cent increase in sales in August at 5,84,456 units as compared to the same month last year.

The company had sold 5,43,406 units in August 2019, Hero MotoCorp said in a statement. In domestic market, the company sold 5,68,674 units, up 8.52 per cent from 5,24,003 units in August 2019. Hero MotoCorp had sold 5,14,509 units in July, thus registering a sequential sales growth of 13 per cent in August, it added. The company said it is witnessing strong retail offtake with semi-urban centres driving the demand. With August marking another step forward in market's recovery, the company cautiously anticipates sales to con-

Sensex jumps

MUMBAI, Sept 1 (PTI)

EQUITY indices returned to winning ways on Tuesday after a day's pause, propelled by Bharti Airtel, HUL and Reliance Industries amid a positive trend in global markets.

A sharp appreciation in the rupee -- which breached the 73-mark against the US dollar -- added to the momentum, traders said. After a choppy session, the BSE Sensex settled 272.51 points or 0.71 per cent higher at 38,900.80. It hit an intra-day high of 39,226.82 and a low of 38,542.11. Similarly, the NSE Nifty advanced 82.75 points or 0.73 per cent to settle at 11,470.25. It touched a high of 11,553.55 and a low of 11,366.90 during the day.

Bharti Airtel was the top gainer in the Sensex pack, rallying 6.38 per cent, after the Supreme Court granted 10 years to telecom firms for paying the adjusted gross revenue (AGR)-related dues to the Government with certain conditions. Bajaj Finance, Asian Paints,

Global cues were positive following Chinese factory data which indicated demand increasing. Liquidity, driven by high FDI inflows in August, has provided good support for the markets, in spite of a general concern regarding high valuations in some sectors and stocks. The market is expecting a slow uptick in economic activity which has resulted in stock specific moves, where there is earnings visibility. Investors need to be prepared to handle volatility in the near term," said Vinod Nair, Head of Research at Geojit Financial Services.
