Postal services to US...

As per the Executive Order, transport carriers delivering shipments through the international postal network, or other “qualified parties” approved by the US Customs and Border Protection (CBP), are required to collect and remit duties on postal shipments.

“While CBP issued certain guidelines on 15th August, 2025, several critical processes relating to the designation of “qualified parties” and mechanisms for duty collection and remittance remain undefined. Consequently, US-bound air carriers have expressed their inability to accept postal con-

signments after 25th August, 2025, citing lack of operational and technical readiness,” a statement from the Ministry said.

Following the development, the “Department of Posts has decided to temporarily suspend booking of all types of postal articles,” destined for the US with effect from August 25, 2025 except letters/documents and gift items up to USD 100 in value, it said. “These exempt categories will continue to be accepted and conveyed to the US, subject to further clarifications from CBP and USPS,” the statement said.

Deep space exploration next...

“Soon, thanks to the hard work of you, scientists, India will launch the Gaganyaan mission and will also build its own space station,” he said.

Shukla asserted that the whole world is excited about India's space program and it is not limited only to the coun-

try. He stated that Japanese and the European Space Agencies are much more excited about the Indian space missions.

“This excitement for India is present all over the world... The Japanese and the European Space Agencies are much more excited about our mission... This is the golden period for our country as far as space exploration is concerned,” Shukla said.

WE ARE GOING TO HAVE A CHANDRAYAAN-4 MISSION, SAYS ISRO CHIEF: While speaking at the main event of the National Space Day in New Delhi, Indian Space Research Organisation chairman V Narayanan announced that India will launch the Chandrayaan 4 mission which will have the Venus Orbiter Mission. The ISRO chief emphasised that by the year 2035, India will establish the “Bharatiya Antariksh Station” whose first module will be lifted off in the year 2035.

He stated that India will land on the Moon by the year 2040 which will make India's space programme at the top other than any country in the world.

SIT arrests complainant who...

Karnataka Home Minister G Parameshwara recently told the Assembly that action could be taken against the complainant if the SIT found his allegations to be false. He also said that, so far, only ground searches have been carried out and that “the probe hasn't even started.”

The SIT alone, and not the Government, would decide on the need for further digging, he added.

POLICE SUMMON YOUTUBER AFTER COURT GRANTS BAIL: The police have issued a notice to YouTuber M D Sameer, who is under the scanner of the Special Investigation Team (SIT), directing him to appear before the investigating officer on August 24, officials said on Saturday. Police said the notice, pasted at his residence in Ballari, came after a Mangaluru court granted Sameer anticipatory bail on August 21.

Sameer faces criminal charges over content related to the Dharmasthala case.

A case has been registered against him at the Dharmasthala police station under Sections 192 (wantonly giving provocation with intent to cause riot), 240 (giving false information) and 353(1)(b) (statements conducing to public mischief) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

According to police, the

charges stem from a video uploaded by Sameer in which he made allegations linked to the case. The SIT is also examining his role as part of its ongoing probe, officials said.

Sameer, who commands a sizeable online following, has maintained that his videos highlight issues ignored by mainstream media. Authorities, however, allege his recent content amounted to provocation and the spread of misinformation, with the potential to disturb public order. While granting anticipatory bail, the court directed Sameer to cooperate with the investigation and refrain from making “inflammatory statements”.

GOVT MAINTAINED THAT ACTION WILL BE TAKEN AGAINST WHO DID WRONG IN DHARMASTHALA CASE: SHIVAKUMAR: Karnataka Deputy Chief Minister D K Shivakumar on Saturday said that the Government has maintained that action will be taken against those who are wrong with regard to the complaint of “multiple murders, rapes and burials” over the past two decades in Dharmasthala.

He said the probe is on in the case, and the Government is on the side of “justice”. The Deputy CM was responding to a question on the arrest of the complainant in this case.

ED arrests K'taka Cong MLA in ‘illegal’ betting case

BENGALURU/NEW DELHI, Aug 23 (PTI)

KARNATAKA Congress MLA K C Veerendra ‘Puppy’ was arrested on Saturday under the anti-money laundering law from Sikkim in an alleged illegal online and offline betting case, the Enforcement Directorate (ED) said.

The federal probe agency also said it seized Rs 12 crore in cash (including about Rs crore in foreign currency), gold jewellery worth Rs 6 crore, silver about 10 kg along with four vehicles following raids launched on Friday in multiple States.

The agency did not specify exactly what was seized from where. A picture issued by the agency showed huge wads of currency notes kept on a casino table. The ED said the 50-year-old MLA from Chitradurga Assembly seat in Karnataka was taken into custody from Sikkim's capital Gangtok on Friday under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) in an “illegal”



online and offline betting case. The legislator had gone to Gangtok along with his associates on a business visit to lease a casino, the agency said.

He was produced before a designated magistrate and a transit remand was obtained for producing him before the jurisdictional court in Bengaluru, the agency said. The Bengaluru zone of the ED is investigating the case. There was no immediate reaction from the MLA's legal team or the Congress party. “Many property-related documents were also seized from the premises of Veerendra's brother K C Nagaraj and his son Pruthvi N Raj.

“His other associates like another brother K C Thippeswamy are handling operations of online gaming from Dubai,” the ED said.

The agency concluded the raids on Saturday from 31 locations that included Chitradurga, Hubballi and Bengaluru in Karnataka, Jodhpur (Rajasthan), Sikkim, Mumbai and Goa.

Hizb-ul-Mujahideen operative arrested in J&K, say police

SRINAGAR, Aug 23 (PTI)

JAMMU and Kashmir Police's State Investigation Agency (SIA) Saturday arrested an over-ground worker (OGW) who worked as a “sleeping cell” for the terrorist organisation Hizb-ul-Mujahideen (HM).

“Following relentless efforts, SIA Kashmir has achieved a major success by apprehending an OGW, Altaf Hussain Wagay, resident of Reban Gund area of Behram in Shopian. The OGW worked as a sleeping cell for the terrorist organisation Hizb-ul-Mujahideen,” a SIA spokesperson said. He said the arrest was made as a part of the ongoing investigation into a case.

SIA Kashmir has adduced evidence which establishes the connection of the arrested accused with a terrorist handler belonging to HM who is operating from across. On the behest of the terrorist handler, the OGW was orchestrating terrorist, unlawful and anti-national activities by actively engaging in terrorist conspiracy, propagating and furthering anti-India narratives.

NEW DELHI, Aug 23 (PTI)

INDIA plans to launch more than 100 satellites over the next 15 years, and it will be a mix of Government technol-

ogy missions and private sector-led operational missions, Science and Technology Minister Jitendra Singh said here on Saturday.

He also released a roadmap for the space sector for the next 15 years during the second National Space Day celebrations in the presence of Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) Chairman V Narayanan, INSPIRE Chairman Pawan Goenka and four astronauts short-listed for the Gaganyaan mission.

Singh said the roadmap will guide India's space journey to 2040 and beyond, supporting the vision of Viksit Bharat by leveraging space technology for food and water security, disaster resilience, environmental sustainability and inclusive growth.

He said India's space programme has entered a transformative phase, where it is no longer confined to symbolic achievements but has become a vital contributor to the country's scientific progress, technological innovation and public welfare.

The Minister added that the opening up of the space sector to private players has brought in a new wave of innovation and entrepreneurship.

B'wood inspired con couple held for duping aspiring actor of Rs 24 lakh

NEW DELHI, Aug 23 (PTI)

DELHI Police has arrested a man and a woman inspired by the movie ‘Bunty aur Babli’ for allegedly duping aspiring actors by posing as TV serial producers and directors in southwest Delhi, an officer said on Saturday.

Tarun Shekhar Sharma, a 32-year-old resident of Lucknow, and Asha Singh alias Bhawna, 29, a resident of Delhi, are linked to more than 20 complaints of a similar kind across the country, DCP (southwest) Amit Goel said. They lured their targets through social media platforms on the pretext of giving them roles in popular TV serials and OTT shows. In the latest case, the complainant was duped of Rs 24 lakh, the officer added. The person came across the self-posing producers' social media page, who were seeking newcomers for a TV show and contacted them, the DCP said.

The complainant was asked for mon-

ey on different pretexts, such as processing and membership charges. She found herself “blocked” after she transferred about Rs 24 lakh, the DCP said. Police followed the money trail and tracked the accused to a rented apartment in Bengaluru and arrested them, the officer said. Seven mobile phones, 10 SIM cards, 15 bank cheque books and passbooks, eight ATM cards and a pair of gold earrings found in their possession were seized.

The accused operated from different cities, frequently changing their locations to evade detection. They stayed in luxury hotels and lived lavishly, police said. “They opened around 15 bank accounts and used multiple SIM cards issued from different states. The fraudsters even trained themselves through online videos,” the officer said.

The accused are also wanted in a case in Jammu and Kashmir and involved in several similar frauds in Uttar Pradesh and Delhi, the DCP said.
