Peel Regional Police said on X Sunday afternoon that they were aware of the protest taking place at the Hindu Sabha Mandir, and had increased its presence at the temple to maintain public order and safety.

"We respect the right to protest in a peaceful and safe manner but will not tolerate violence and criminal acts," Chief Nishan Duraipapp posted on X Sunday after the videos began circulating.

"Those that do participate in this activity will be pursued, arrested and charged." Peel police told CBC Toronto no arrests were made at the temple Sunday.

Police did not provide further details about the social media videos, what happened or whether any complaints were filed. Brampton Mayor Patrick Brown condemned the violence in a post on X Sunday afternoon, saying those responsible should be punished to the greatest extent of the law.

"I am disappointed to hear about acts of violence outside of the Hindu Sabha," he

said. "Religious freedom is a foundational value in Canada. Everyone should feel safe in their place of worship." The recent attack on the Hindu Sabha temple in Brampton witnessed widespread condemnation by Canadian politicians, including Opposition leader Pierre Poilievre.

"Completely unacceptable to see violence targeting worshippers at the Hindu Sabha Mandir in Brampton today. All Canadians should be free to practice their faith in peace. Conservatives condemn this violence unequivocally. I will unite our people and end the chaos," Poilievre said on X.

Premier Doug Ford praised police for their "quick response," adding that the incident is "completely unacceptable and must be condemned. No one should feel unsafe at their place of worship," he wrote on X.

The Indian High Commission remarked, "We have seen violent disruption today (November 3), orchestrated by anti-India elements outside the consular camp co-organised with the Hindu Sabha Mandir in Brampton, near Toronto."

He condemned the three leaders as "cowards" and added, "Not one of these cowards dares to even name the Khalistani Sikhs who are committing the violence. They're afraid to offend some voters, even though Khalistani supporters are a minority of Sikh Canadians."

"This complacency explains why Khalistani extremism keeps growing in this country," he stated, sharing the screenshots of the social media posts.

The criticism follows an attack near the Hindu Sabha

Temple in Brampton, where devotees were reportedly targeted by individuals believed to be affiliated with Khalistani groups. Peel Police were stationed outside the temple, though no arrests have been made yet.

Earlier, Bernier posted a video on X showing the alleged attack, stating that such incidents cannot intimidate Canadians who believe that diversity is the nation's strength. He added, "Khalistani Sikhs attacking worshippers at Brampton Hindu temple. Nothing to worry about though because diversity is our strength!!!"

36 killed as bus falls into...

said District Magistrate Alok Kumar Pandey. The bus plunged into a 200-metre gorge in Almora's Marchula area 35 km before its destination Ramnagar, he said.

Visuals from the area pointed to the magnitude of the accident, the vehicle reduced to a mangled mess as it rolled down the forested, rocky slope and stopped just short of a stream. Rescuers could be seen working to pull out the passengers. A magisterial probe has been ordered and the assistant regional transport officers of Pauri and Almora suspended. "The news of the death of many people, including women and children, in a road accident in Almora, Uttarakhand is heart-rending. I express my deepest condolences to the bereaved families and pray

for the speedy recovery of those injured," President Droupadi Murmu said in a post on X.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Home Minister Amit Shah and Defence Minister Rajnath Singh also expressed their grief at the loss of lives in the accident and prayed for the quick recovery of the injured. The Prime Minister announced an ex-gratia payment of Rs 2 lakh for the next of kin of the deceased and an assistance of Rs 50,000 for the injured. He said the local administration is making every possible effort for relief and rescue.

Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami, who was on his way to the accident spot, announced a compensation of Rs 4 lakh for the next of kin and financial assistance of Rs 1 lakh for the injured.

decided by the results in seven battle ground states of Arizona, Nevada, Wisconsin, Michigan, Pennsylvania, North Carolina and Georgia. Of these, Michigan and Pennsylvania play key role to them reaching the 270-mark.

The presidential race appears to be hurtling toward a photo finish, with the final set of polls by The New York Times and Siena College finding Harris gaining new strength in North Carolina and Georgia even as Trump erases her lead in Pennsylvania and maintains his advantage in Arizona, the daily reported Sunday.

According to The New York Times, Harris is now narrowly

ahead in Nevada, North Carolina and Wisconsin, the poll show, while Trump leads in Arizona. "The polls show them locked in close races in Michigan, Georgia and Pennsylvania. But the results in all seven states are within the margin of sampling error, meaning neither candidate has a definitive lead in any of them," the daily reported.

The Real Clear Politics, which tracks all the major national and battleground polls, said it's a tie between Trump and Harris. In the national polls, Trump leads by 0.1 percentage points, and in battleground states the former President has an edge of 0.9 percentage points.

tightened. But, beyond these regional issues which are of immediate concern, the fundamental factors do not support higher oil prices," said the report. The estimates by OPEC, International Energy Agency (IEA), and the USEIA present a picture of over-supply of oil in the coming year. These estimates differ in the magnitude of over-supply but have a common

ground in supply which is in excess of the demand growth. Yet another factor is the fact that the demand from China for oil is weak. It has been more pronounced in the last three months.

This is reported to be due to weak demand in the local market mainly for diesel and gasoline. Chinese refining of oil has also come down in the last three months.

Court frames charges against RG Kar case prime accused

KOLKATA, Nov 4 (PTI)

EIGHTY-SEVEN days after the body of a woman medic was found at state-run RG Kar Medical College and Hospital, a Kolkata court on Monday framed charges against the prime accused, Sanjay Roy.

The court announced that day-to-day trial in the case would commence from November 11. Roy has been booked under Section 64 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (rape), Section 66 (punishment for causing death or resulting in a persistent vegetative state) and 103 (punishment for murder).

"I have done nothing. I have been framed in this rape-murder case. Nobody is listening to me. The Government is framing me and threatening me not to open my mouth," Roy told

reporters as he was led out of the Sealdah court.

Roy was arrested by the Kolkata Police on August 10, a day after the on-duty woman doctor's body was found inside the seminar room of the RG Kar

hospital. Later, the CBI took up the investigation into the case on a Calcutta High Court order.

Senior West Bengal Congress leader Adhir Chowdhury said that Roy's claims should be taken seriously and probed.

Court directs ED to supply chargesheet, documents to Excise Policy case accused

NEW DELHI, Nov 4 (PTI)

A COURT here on Monday directed the ED to supply copies of the chargesheet and other documents to the accused in the alleged money laundering case related to the Delhi Excise Policy.

Special Judge Kaveri Baweja directed the Enforcement Directorate (ED) to carry out the exercise by November 13, when the matter would be heard next. Delhi's former Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and AAP leader Manish Sisodia, both currently out on bail, appeared before the court through video conferencing.

The judge was told by some of the defence counsel that they had not received soft copies of

the chargesheet and other related documents.

The judge also noted the ED's submission that it needed "some more time" to supply the copy of digitised record/soft copies of remaining documents/devices to the accused.

The Excise case pertains to charges of alleged corruption and money laundering in formulating and executing the Delhi Government's Excise Policy for 2021-22, which was scrapped subsequently. Delhi Lieutenant Governor V K Saxena had recommended a Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) probe into the alleged irregularities. Subsequently, the ED registered a case under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA).

Court convicts 3 for collectorate blast in Kollam

KOLLAM (Kerala), Nov 4 (PTI)

A KERALA court on Monday found three persons guilty in connection with a low-intensity IED blast at the Kollam district Collectorate in 2016.

The convicts were linked to an extremist group promoting the ideology of Al-Qaeda leader Osama Bin Laden. A fourth accused was acquitted due to insufficient evidence.

District Principal Sessions Court Judge G Gopakumar delivered the verdict, finding Abbas Ali (first accused) from Madurai's Ismail Puram, Shamsun Karim Raja (second accused) from Madurai's K Pudur, and Dawood Sulaiman (third accused) from Madurai's Pallivasal guilty.

Opposition MPs indicate move to disassociate from Waqf panel

NEW DELHI, Nov 4 (PTI)

OPPOSITION MPs in the parliamentary committee scrutinising the Waqf (Amendment) Bill are scheduled to meet Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla on Tuesday to protest its chairperson Jagdambika Pal's alleged "unilateral" decisions and attempts to "bulldoze" proceedings, indicating that they may disassociate themselves from the panel.

Claiming that they have been "stonewalled" during the committee's proceedings, Opposition MPs have listed their grievances, including objections against the proposed law, in the letter addressed to Birla.

Opposition sources said they have prepared a joint letter -- signed by a number of MPs, including Congress's Mohammad Jawed and Imran Masood, DMK's Raja, AIMIM's Asaduddin Owaisi, AAP's Sanjay Singh and TMC's Kalyan Banerjee -- that will be submitted to the Speaker on Tuesday.

They accused Pal, a four-term MP representing the BJP, of taking "unilateral decisions" on fixing the dates of sittings -- which were at times for three consecutive days -- and whom to call witnesses. They said it is not practically possible for MPs to interact with depositors with adequate preparation.

PM Vishwakarma scheme has 2.58 crore artisans on board

NEW DELHI, Nov 4 (IANS)

THE Centre's PM Vishwakarma Yojana to uplift traditional craftspeople and artisans such as carpenters, masons and tailors has made considerable headway with as many as 2.58 crore applications being submitted so far.

Of these, 23.75 lakh applicants have been successfully registered for receiving benefits under the scheme after the three-stage verification process, according to data compiled by the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC). Close to 10 lakh people have received toolkit incentives

of up to Rs 15,000 through e-vouchers under the scheme to buy modern tools suitable for their occupation.

As of 29.07.2024, loan sanctions have been granted to 56,526 applications, totalling Rs 551.80 crore. The loan carries a 5 per cent interest rate, subsidised by the government. The Government of India provides 8 per cent interest subvention, effectively reducing the overall loan cost. The loan can be repaid over 18 months for the first tranche and 30 months for the second tranche. The PM Vishwakarma Scheme was launched on September 17 last year.

MUDA: Lokayukta Police summon Siddaramaiah

MYSURU, Nov 4 (PTI)

THE Lokayukta police have summoned Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah for questioning in the MUDA site allotment case on November 6, official sources said on Monday. They had on October 25 questioned his wife Parvathi B M, who is also an accused in the case. "We asked him to appear on Wednesday morning," a senior Lokayukta official told PTI.

The CM is facing allegations of illegalities in the allotment of 14 sites to his wife by the Mysuru Urban Development Authority (MUDA). Reacting to Lokayukta police summons, Siddaramaiah, speaking to reporters in Haveri district, said: "I will go..." Siddaramaiah, his wife, brother-in-law Mallikarjuna Swamy and

Devaraju -- from whom Swamy had purchased a land and gifted it to Parvathi -- and others have been named in the FIR registered by the Mysuru-located Lokayukta police establishment on September 27. Swamy and Devaraju have also deposed before the Lokayukta police.

The CM on October 24 filed an appeal before the division bench of the High Court, challenging the decision of a single judge bench in connection with the MUDA site allotment case that had come as a setback to him. The bench of Justice M Nagaprasanna had on September 24 dismissed the CM's petition challenging Governor Thaaawarchand Gehlot's approval for a probe against him in the case, observing that the gubernatorial order nowhere "suffers from want of application of mind".

DECIDE or we will consider it: SC to Centre on Rajoana's mercy petition

NEW DELHI, Nov 4 (PTI)

THE Supreme Court on Monday said it would consider the mercy petition of death row convict Balwant Singh Rajoana, convicted in the 1995 assassination case of then Punjab Chief Minister Beant Singh, if the Centre does not decide on it "either way".

A bench of Justices BR Gavai, P K Mishra and K V Viswanathan adjourned for two weeks the former Punjab Police constable's plea seeking commutation of his death sentence to life term due to an "inordinate delay" in deciding his mercy petition. "Decide it either way or we will consider it (Rajoana's plea)," the bench

told Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Centre, after he informed the court that Rajoana's mercy plea was pending with the President's house. Rajoana has been in continuous custody for 29 years, said his counsel, senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi, while seeking his release till the mercy petition is decided.

"His mercy petition has been pending with the President's house for the past 12 years. Please release him for six or three months. At least let him see what the outside world looks like," Rohatgi submitted.

The bench was informed by the Punjab Government that they need some time to file their counter affidavit in the

case. Mehta also submitted that Rajoana was convicted for assassinating the sitting Chief Minister of Punjab and he needs to seek instructions on the issue. The bench told Rohatgi, "We will give them two weeks time to file their counter-affidavit. We need to see their response." On September 25, the top court had sought responses from the Centre, the Punjab Government and the administration of the union territory of Chandigarh on Rajoana's plea. The then Punjab CM and 16 others were killed in a blast at the entrance of the Civil Secretariat in Chandigarh on August 31, 1995. A special court sentenced Rajoana to death in July 2007.

SC relaxes Kerala scribe Kappan's bail condition in Hathras case

NEW DELHI, Nov 4 (PTI)

THE Supreme Court on Monday relaxed the bail condition imposed on Kerala journalist Siddique Kappan in a UAPA case saying he doesn't have to report to a Uttar Pradesh police station every week. A bench of Justices P S Narasimhan and Sandeep Mehta relaxed the condition imposed by the top court on Kappan at the time of his bail in September, 2022.

Kappan was arrested in October, 2020 while on his way to UP's Hathras, where a Dalit woman had died after allegedly being sexually assaulted by a group of men.
