Notice is hereby given that the Sixty-fifth Annual General Meeting ("AGM") of the Members of Narmada Gelatines Limited will be held on Wednesday, 19th August, 2026 at 11.00 a.m. (IST), via video conferencing/ other audio visual means ("VC/OAVM") to transact the following business:

ORDINARY BUSINESS

1. To receive consider and adopt the audited Standalone and Consolidated Financial Statements of the Company for the year ended 31st March, 2026 including the Reports of the Board of Directors and Auditors thereon and in this respect to consider and if thought fit, to pass the following **resolution as an Ordinary Resolution**:

"RESOLVED THAT the audited Standalone and Consolidated Financial Statements of the Company for the year ended 31st March, 2026, including the Balance Sheet as at that date and the Statement of Profit and Loss Account and the Cash Flow Statement for the year ended on that date together with the Reports of the Directors and Auditors thereon as laid before this Meeting be and are hereby approved and adopted."

The Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") has vide its General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020 and 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, and subsequent circulars issued in this regard, the latest being 3/2025 dated September 22, 2025, (collectively referred to as "MCA Circulars") has permitted the companies to hold their Annual General Meeting ("AGM") through Video Conference ("VC") or through Other Audio Visual Means ("OAVM"), without the physical presence of the Members at a common venue. He is also on the Board of Standard Fireworks Pvt. Ltd., Sivakasi, Pioneer Asia Group of Companies, Sivakasi and India Gelatines and Chemicals Limited. The Group has interest in various business enterprises like Safety Matches, Printing, Textiles, Wind Energy and Chemicals in India, Sri Lanka, Taiwan & Netherlands

Mr. S. Maheswaran shall retire at the ensuing Annual General Meeting of the Company and being eligible offer himself for re-appointment.

Mr. S. Maheswaran gives overall guidance in framing Business policies. Regulation 17(1A) of SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 requires the listed entities to obtain approval of the shareholders by way of Special Resolution to appoint or continue the Directorship of any Non-Executive Non-Independent Director who have attained the age of 75 Years or more.

The Board at its meeting held on 25th May, 2026 is of the opinion that Mr. S. Maheswaran vast knowledge and varied industry experience will be of great value to the Company and has recommended the Resolution at Item No. 3 of this Notice as a Special Resolution (since Mr. S. Krishnamoorthy), was appointed as a Non-Executive Independent Director of the Company at the 60th Annual General Meeting held on 21st September, 2021 and who holds office up to the conclusion of the 65th Annual General Meeting, upon attaining the age of 75 years on 26th December, 2025, approval of the Members by way of a Special Resolution through Postal Ballot was obtained in accordance with Regulation 17(1A) of the Listing Regulations for continuation of his directorship up to the expiry of his current term, i.e., till the conclusion of the 65th Annual General Meeting or 20th September, 2026, whichever is earlier.

The Nomination and Remuneration Committee and the Board are of the opinion that the continued association of Mr. K. Krishnamoorthy would be beneficial to the Company, and the Company would continue to benefit from his legal acumen, corporate experience, and valuable insights. Accordingly, the Board recommends the Resolution set out at Item No. 4 of this Notice as a Special Resolution for approval of the Members, in compliance with Regulation 17(1A) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, since he has attained the age of 75 years.

Mr. K. Krishnamoorthy, aged 75 years, holds a Bachelor's Degree in Commerce (Honours) from Calcutta University and a Bachelor of Laws (LLB) degree from Utkal University, Bhubaneswar. He is a qualified Company Secretary and holds a Certificate of Practice (CP No. 9733). He has also passed the Intermediate Examination of the Institute of Cost and Works Accountants of India.

Mr. K Krishnamoorthy has gained expertise in the field of restructuring such as mergers / acquisitions, resource mobilization through public issue/rights issue, QIP/ FCCB/ GDR and Corporate Governance. Undertaken scores of mergers/demergers in various listed companies such as erstwhile Brooke Bond India Limited, Ceeta Industries Limited and erstwhile Shaw Wallace & Company Limited.

He has held various positions in Sourcing, Secretarial, Legal and Finance Departments in companies such as Brooke Bond India Limited, Kolkata (since merged with Hindustan Unilever Limited), Utkal Asbestos Limited, Bhubaneswar, Ceeta Industries Limited, Kolkata, before joining erstwhile Shaw Wallace & Company Limited, (since merged with United Spirits Limited, Bengaluru - now a subsidiary of Diageo plc., U.K.) as General Manager (Finance) and Company Secretary, overseeing the secretarial/legal/finance functions of its various liquor/beer manufacturing, real estate and consumer electronic subsidiary companies (both listed and unlisted) and its associate companies. After successful career of 2 decades in various corporate bodies, he retired from United Spirits Limited as "Assistant Vice President - Secretarial/Corporate Legal" in December, 2010. However, he continued in the capacity of "Advisor" on retainership basis till September, 2015 in their Corporate Legal/Secretarial Department.

During his tenure with the Company, Mr. Krishnamoorthy has attended all Board and Committee meetings and has provided valuable guidance and inputs in the best interests of the Company and its stakeholders.

Mr. Ashok K. Kapur's previous term as the Managing director of the Company expired on May 31, 2026.

Pursuant to the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, the Board of Directors of the Company vide resolution passed on May 25, 2026 approved re-appointment of Mr. Ashok K. Kapur as the Managing Director of the Company with effect from June 1, 2026 in accordance with the provisions contained in Section 196 and 197 read with Section 203 of the Companies Act, 2013, subject to approval of members.

Since, Mr. Ashok K. Kapur has attained the age of 78 years and as per Schedule V of the Companies Act, 2013, the approval of shareholders by Special Resolution at the general meeting of the Company or approval of the Central Government would be required for his re-appointment as Managing Director. This explanatory statement may also be read and treated as disclosure in compliance with the requirements of Section 190 of the Companies Act, 2013.

Mr Ashok K. Kapur is a Mechanical Engineer having 55 years of experience in Gelatine industry. He has contributed immensely to the growth of the Company and his vast and rich experience in Gelatine Industry will be beneficial to the company. He has been the Chairman of Ossein & Gelatine Manufacturers' Association of India and a Director of Gelatine Manufacturers Association of Asia Pacific and the Ex-Chairman of Ossein and Gelatine Panel of CAPEXIL. He is overall in-charge of the Company embracing the whole gamut of operations.

The details of remuneration payable to Mr. Ashok K. Kapur and the terms and conditions of the appointment are given below:

- Period of appointment** - 2 years from June 1, 2026 to May 31, 2028. His appointment is not liable to retirement by rotation.
- Nature of Duties:** Mr. Ashok K.  5. The terms and conditions of the appointment may be altered and varied from time to time by the Board as it may, in its discretion deem fit, subject to such approvals as may be required.
 6. The terms and conditions of the appointment of Mr. Ashok K. Kapur also include clauses pertaining to adherence with the Code of Conduct, no conflict of interest with the Company and maintenance of confidentiality.
 7. Mr. Ashok K. Kapur shall not become interested or otherwise concerned, directly or through his spouse and/or children, in any selling agency of the Company.

None of the director, except Mr. Ashok K Kapur, is deemed to be interested or concerned in his re-appointment and remuneration payable to him as a managing director. The terms of re-appointment of Mr. Ashok K.
